



## 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Family Milk Jug Boat Regatta

### Schedule

9:30-10:00 – Team Check-in / Registration

10:00-10:15 AM – Rules Review / Q&A

10:15-12:30 PM – Boat Building and Lunch (Food available beginning at 11:30, eat while you build).

12:30-1:45 PM – Races

1:45 – Awards Ceremony (prizes to be determined based upon number of teams entered)

2:00 – Boat teardown/recycling and park clean up

### Rules

1. Each boat must have a minimum of 2 people on board
2. All boat riders must wear a life jacket and protective footwear
3. Boats can be propelled by hand or 'on-sight manufactured' paddles; (no use of commercial paddles, oars, etc or use of feet with the exception of the initial push from shore)
4. **NO** outside construction/assembly materials allowed.
5. Outside decoration materials are permitted provided they do not aid in floatation or assembly.
6. All building kits are not created equally!!! Materials may be swapped, given or combined (only one prize per boat regardless of number of participants, if combining with another team, you must notify the registration table by 11:30)
7. Brackets and race heat sizes to be determined at the close of registration
8. Know your team number/name and be ready to race when called
9. Rules subject to change/modification as deemed necessary by race officials
10. Decisions of race officials are final
11. Be creative, have fun and be careful

### Tips / General Info

- A single milk jug will support approximately 8 pounds
- Check caps (tighten screw caps and tape snap caps)
